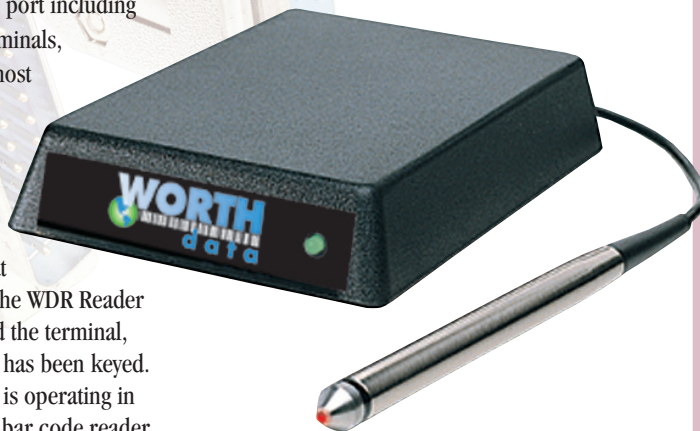

## RS-232 Serial Reader

A Bar Code Reader to attach to any device with an RS-232 serial port including UNIX and LINUX Terminals, laptops, cash registers, and most micro and mini computers.



### Serial Wedge Attachment

For multi-user computers that use LINUX, UNIX, PICK, etc., the WDR Reader attaches between the host and the terminal, transmitting data as though it has been keyed. Any ASCII serial terminal that is operating in character mode can have the bar code reader act as a 2nd keyboard. The bar code reader attaches using a serial "Y" cable between the host cable and the terminal. Simply unplug the serial cable from your multi-user terminal and plug it into one end of the the WDR's serial "Y" cable, then take the cable plugged into the other end of the "Y" cable and connect it to the main port of the terminal. When data is keyed or wanded, the data is transmitted to the host computer which echoes the data back through the WDR reader to the terminal's screen; bar codes appear to have been keyed.

### Multiple Readers per Computer

If you need more than one bar code reader on a computer, you can attach up to 32 WDR Readers by RS-232 daisy-chaining or RS-422 multi-dropping.

### Laptop Attachment

- Serial "Y" cable for in-line attachment between host and terminal - for UNIX and LINUX
- Transmits data in ASCII format by RS-232 or optional RS-422
- Reader can be located 100+ feet from computer (RS-232)
- Wand, Laser, Slot Badge and Magstripe Scanners
- RS-422 can be up to 4000 ft.
- 2 scanners possible
- Multiple Readers per computer (1-32) by daisy chain or multi-drop
- Over 100 Configurable Options
- Two Year Warranty

Most laptops don't have an external keyboard port, so bar code readers may need to be attached to the laptop's serial port. The WDR attaches to a serial port using a program called PortKey. The serial data is placed in the keyboard buffer making the data appear to have been keyed. Sold with the WDR, PortKey is only \$40 (\$99 if ordered separately). It is available for Windows® only.

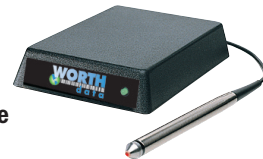
